

The Episcopal Diocese of Lexington and the Episcopal Diocese of Haiti are Companion Dioceses – a mutually established relationship of prayer, encouragement and for the exchange of spiritual and material resources. Since the adoption of this relationship in 2003, Haitians have seen the terrible consequences of a fallen government and the violent effects of anarchy. Without a viable government or social infrastructure in place to distribute services, the Haitian people are frequently bereft of food, clean water, medical supplies and the means to control violence.

The proceeds from last years' race went toward the purchase of a \$30K food distribution truck in cooperation with Food for the Poor, Inc. to deliver food to rural areas in Haiti. This years' proceeds will go toward continued tangible assistance to these neighbors in need.

Joining us as a runner, walker, watcher and/or financial contributor in the HOPE for HAITI 5K Run/Walk at Keeneland Racecourse on December 3, 2005 is a great way to demonstrate awareness and solidarity with those in need and ultimately to provide humanitarian aid to Haiti.
